French curiosities This tabletop game boasts a simple and elegant aesthetic, typical of late 19th or early 20th-century productions. It bears the gold "MF" (Manufacture Française d'Armes et Cycles de Saint-Étienne) stamp on its side, a guarantee of French quality and technical precision. The circular playing surface is adorned with eight geometric diamond-shaped inlays. The moving center is made of nickel-plated metal with a finely turned launching handle; the central pivoting mechanism is perfectly smooth. The roulette wheel comes with two balls and four boxes of white metal tokens, marked with the number 1 or 2 within a laurel wreath. It is in good condition with some signs of wear consistent with its age.
