Description

This piece is a pressed-molded glass bowl or salad bowl, displaying a classic style widely popular in Europe. It features a "Diamond Point" pattern combined with palmette motifs (the fan-shaped forms at the top of the sides). The rim is scalloped and undulating, giving it a highly detailed appearance. There is a small chip on the underside of the piece, but this does not affect its aesthetic appeal or functionality. Technical details: This is molded glass. The inscription "Registered Design" confirms that it is a piece of French or European industrial production. This designation was used to protect the design from counterfeiting at the time of its commercialization. This provides some further details: * Confirmation of the period: This designation was widely used from the late 19th

century until the 1950s. Given the style, the likely period is between 1910 and 1940. *

Manufacturing quality: This indicates that the piece came from an established crystal or glassworks (such as Baccarat or Saint-Louis) that considered the design valuable enough to be legally protected.
