### Description

This object is a handcrafted butcher's block mounted on a wooden base. It is a rustic and decorative piece of kitchen furniture that combines several interesting elements: \* The block (upper part): This is a thick section of wood designed to withstand knife and cleaver blows. The metal reinforcements in the corners prevent the wood from splitting over time and due to humidity variations. \* The base: The legs are solid to ensure stability during cutting. The carved "sawtooth" or scalloped detail under the drawer adds a traditional aesthetic touch. \* The horse's head: This is a very distinctive element. Historically, cast-iron horse heads were often found at the entrance of horsemeat butcher shops. Here, it serves as a towel hook or simply as a themed decoration. \* The drawer: Equipped with a
