Description

Important terracotta statue depicting a draped male figure in the classical style, holding a cup, probably Bacchus (Dionysus), god of wine and revelry. The vegetal wreath, the raised cup, and the swaying pose directly reference Bacchic iconography from Antiquity. A high-quality piece, characteristic of the Neoclassical taste of the Restoration period (circa 1815-1830), and inspired by antique models then very fashionable in decorative and workshop sculpture. Beautifully modeled, with meticulous treatment of the drapery and harmonious proportions. It rests on a molded circular base. Homogeneous antique patina, very good condition, minor damage to the arm (see photo). Dimensions: - Height 141 cm - Width 32 cm - Depth 37 cm.
