Infantry officer's saber, Louis XVI-Revolution period, 18th century. Grip covered in filigreed leather. Brass hilt with a pommel surmounted by a rivet button and a long tail. Openwork single-branch guard and longitudinally cut guard plate with two reinforcing rings near the middle. Guilloché knuckle guard and guard plate edges. Curved blade with a single cutting edge and a pointed false edge, fuller, and back groove. Stained blade. Leather scabbard with two cut brass mounts. Chape with button and long locket. Length: 88 cm. Length without scabbard: 84 cm. Blade length: 69 cm. Blade width at the ricasso: 3.5 cm. False edge length: 15 cm. Good condition, showing its original patina, see details in the photos.
