Three-Piece Spelter Mantel Clock Set - 19th Century. An elegant three-piece patinated spelter mantel clock set dating from the 19th century, depicting a draped female figure in the antique style, seated and reading, a classical allegory of the arts or reflection. The finely modeled sculpture rests on an architecturally designed base of fine veined marble. The circular enamel dial with Arabic numerals is framed by a gilt brass bezel. The movement is integrated into a block of marble forming the clock's body. The set is completed by two matching decorative cassolettes, placed on either side, reinforcing the symmetry and decorative character of the piece.
