There, he attended the studio of René Jaudon (1889-1966) for lithography and the studio of Jean Souverbie (1891-1981) for painting. At the beginning of his career, starting in 1946, he created figurative works (landscapes, nudes, still lifes, etc.). Around 1954, forms were still present but began to give way to color and composition. It was in the 1960s that he definitively embraced abstraction. Throughout his career, he exhibited in various Parisian salons: Salon d'Automne, Salon des Indépendants, Salon
