This lithograph on China paper, "Parisian Landscapes - The Pont des Saints-Pères and the Louvre," is signed Henri Rivière and bears a red stamp in the lower right corner. We note some small stains, creases, and minor tears in the margins. The lithograph itself shows traces of creases and small stains. The colors are perfect; once framed, these imperfections will be barely visible. We have taken numerous photos of the flaws so you can assess the condition. Sold as presented. Henri Rivière (1864-1951) was a French painter, engraver, and illustrator. He began his career with drawing, then moved on to intaglio engraving, specifically etching, in 1882. Simultaneously, in 1886, he embarked on a career as a director and set designer, creating shadow puppet theater at the Chat Noir cabaret,
