



Louis XV Style Commode, Curved, 18th Century

Description

An elegant Louis XV style commode, opening at the front with two wide drawers without a central divider, its curved lines characteristic of the mid-18th century. It is crafted from finely inlaid veneer, with the marquetry arranged in a frieze pattern and geometric frieze, highlighted by light wood stringing forming frames and panels, emphasizing the richness of the decoration. The front and sides have a harmonious curve, resting on four cabriole legs terminating in finely chased gilt-bronze sabots. The whole is richly adorned with gilt and chased bronze mounts: foliate drawer pulls, openwork keyhole escutcheons, sculpted corner mounts, and a prominent central bronze rocaille motif at the bottom. All of this testifies to meticulous decorative work, in keeping with the spirit of 18th-century French

taste. The top is finished with a red veined marble slab, likely Griotte or Languedoc red marble, with a molded edge that perfectly follows the curved lines of the piece. Condition: very good condition, with a warm patina on the wood and bronze mounts. A few minor signs of age and use, consistent with its age and condition, do not detract from its aesthetic appeal or structural integrity. This decorative and refined commode would be ideally suited to a classic or contemporary interior, whether in a bedroom, living room, or office, and perfectly embodies the Louis XV style.
