Refined Louis XVI period dressing table, also suitable as a small writing table, dating to the late 18th century and distinguished by excellent craftsmanship and refined materials. The piece features clean, elegant lines typical of Neoclassical taste and is veneered in fine bois de rose and rosewood, carefully arranged in balanced geometric patterns. The tapered legs are fitted with gilt bronze mounts to the feet, of good quality and well preserved. The top is composed of three hinged sections, with the central panel lifting to reveal an original mirror, allowing the table to function as a true dressing table. The front includes drawers with oak interiors, while the main structure is in fir, consistent with late 18th-century construction practices.
