Description

This sturdy hunting cutlass is impressive. It is Italian and dates from the 18th century. It is in its original, discovering condition, never cleaned, never restored, with a beautiful patina from use.

BLADE : It is a thick, single-edged blade. A fine fuller runs along each face. Near the ricasso, there are four serrated notches on the cutting edges, designed to cut tendons and possibly bones. The back edge of the blade shows numerous marks from use as a cutting board cleaver. The blade is attached to the hilt by a baluster-shaped steel section. Blade length = 27 cm, width at the ricasso = 4.4 cm, thickness at the ricasso = 10 mm.

GRIP : It has eight facets, is made of dark horn, and shows brass tabs in the center of each face. Brass ferrules. The pommel is brass and decorated with a small flower where the tang of
