Description

A significant carved wooden decorative element depicting a stylized cloud, entirely gilded with gold leaf. Extending over a length of 140 cm, this cloud features a broad and deeply dynamic modeling, characteristic of the Rococo style of the 18th century. The sculpture boasts a generous relief, rhythmic with a succession of bulges and hollows with supple and dynamic contours, evoking the celestial clouds of grand religious decorations. The gilding, applied with gold leaf over a traditional ground, retains beautiful original patches. Natural wear and slight translucency of the gilding lend the piece a warm and authentic patina, perfectly consistent with its period. Given its size and horizontal composition, this element likely crowned: an altarpiece or altar, a set of church or chapel woodwork, or a
