A glazed earthenware tea and coffee service, known as Namur earthenware. Engraved silver mounts. Includes a coffee pot, a teapot, and a milk jug. Namur, Belgium. This set comprises three pieces of 18th-century Namur black earthenware, including a teapot and two coffee pots, with silver mounts. These pieces are part of a rare collection of tableware, typical of Namur faïence. The pieces are characterized by their glossy black glaze and are often mounted in silver, including chains connecting the lids. This tableware is considered a reference collection for 18th-century Belgian heritage. Some minor chips.
