Description

Oil on panel, signed Léon Jouhaud (1884-1950), a painter and enameller from Limoges. This work depicts a rural landscape of the Limousin region, with houses with red roofs, a winding path, and vegetation rendered in broad areas of color. The composition emphasizes the construction of masses and the atmosphere, in a restrained and structured style characteristic of artists associated with the Crozant School. The harmonious palette blends greens, mauves, and ochres, reflecting a search for light and depth, while maintaining a clear and accessible style. The work is executed in oil on panel, a support frequently used for its stability and the quality of the finish. The painting is signed and presented in a frame with a textile mat, which complements the overall composition.
