Superb hand-decorated slipware plate, typical of the Art Deco aesthetic of the 1930s. The floral design features three delicate flowers--a rose, a zinnia, and a dahlia--finely modeled in relief, enhancing the piece with an expression that is both elegant and vibrant. Each flower is carefully sculpted, highlighting the artisanal skill of the period. The slipware technique, which involves applying a slightly thicker ceramic paste to create relief, gives this plate a sculptural dimension while maintaining a refined decorative finesse. Diameter: 22 cm. This plate is equally suited to decorative wall or display case presentation or for use in an antique ceramics collection. Condition: good condition, see imperfections in photos. This is an ideal piece for lovers of Art Deco, early 20th-century French ceramics, or for enriching a
