In perfect condition and true to their original design, these bread bowls are exquisitely ornamental and make two beautiful serving dishes with their finely chased, openwork, and scalloped edges and footed bases. Remarkably crafted and monogrammed, they are a precious addition to a refined table setting and can be used in a variety of ways. These rare pieces from America embody the art of French dining, a fact that did not escape the notice of the renowned New York silversmith. Of generous proportions, with a perfect polish and harmonious form, this lovely pair is marked on the sole and engraved with the name of the American
