Jacques-Antoine Leclerc (1744 - January 30, 1792), cabinetmaker. Paris. Master on September 29, 1779. He worked on rue du Faubourg-Saint-Antoine, then rue des Barres, and finally in the courtyard of the Jewish Quarter. This cabinetmaker produced well-made Louis XV and Louis XVI furniture.
