Description

Large blown and hot-worked glass bowl, signed Adam Jablonski under the base. The thick glass features an internal decoration of metal wires embedded within the molten glass, creating particularly rich optical and luminous effects. The linear design structures the material and gives the piece a strong sculptural presence. Adam Jablonski (born in April 1936 in Wilczkowice, Poland) is a Polish master glassmaker and glass engineer, active in the second half of the 20th century. Trained in glass techniques from the 1950s onward, he developed a practice in his Wólka Kosowska studio based on experimentation with materials and the integration of innovative technical processes, notably the insertion of metal wires into molten glass.
