Description

Blue and White Ceramic Covered Pot - Vietnam, 19th Century. An interesting covered ceramic pot with underglaze blue decoration, likely of Vietnamese origin, dating from the 19th century. The piece has a globular shape resting on a small foot, topped with its original flat lid. The decoration, painted with cobalt, consists of stylized floral motifs and scrolls, executed with great spontaneity, characteristic of wares produced for the Vietnamese market during this period. The slightly creamy clay reveals a beautiful antique texture, with natural irregularities and a patina consistent with the object's age. The deep, nuanced blue contrasts pleasantly with the light background, giving the piece a striking decorative presence. This type of pot was traditionally intended for domestic use or
