Description

A pair of 18th-century polychrome terracotta sculptures depicting soldiers in 18th-century uniform, attributed to the sculptor Matera and created in the Trapani area, one of the most active and skilled centers of Sicilian sculpture production of the period. The figures feature energetic and highly expressive modeling, with distinctive faces, well-defined hands, and dynamic postures--elements that demonstrate a skilled hand and a style fully rooted in late Baroque style. The use of real fabric applied to the clothing, still partially preserved, is a typical feature of 18th-century Trapani production.
