Brass "Mushroom" Table Lamp - SS France. This elegant "mushroom" shaped table lamp, crafted from brass and mounted on a teak base, is an iconic feature of 1960s French naval design. This model corresponds to the lighting fixtures used aboard the legendary SS France, notably for illuminating the first-class lounges and dining rooms. The clean lines, combining a hemispherical dome and a cylindrical stem, perfectly illustrate the functional and refined aesthetic developed for the great transatlantic liners. The brass has a beautiful, even patina, a testament to its long and authentic use, favoring original charm over modern polishing. The teak base, a later addition, reflects the reinforcement work carried out during the ship's dismantling. A piece with a decidedly modern character,
