Parisian work from the Louis XV period, circa 1750. Chiffoniers are small pieces of lady's furniture, intended for furnishing 18th-century bedrooms to store clothing. They can be used as bedside tables on either side of a high four-poster bed, between windows, or as end tables for a sofa. A beautiful and highly decorative set, a true pair like the one we are offering is a very rare opportunity. Ideal for completing an 18th-century collection or décor.
