Exceptional French chandelier in gilt bronze and finely cut crystal, attributed to the renowned Cristalleries de Baccarat manufactory and dating from the late 19th century. This refined lighting piece embodies the excellence of French decorative arts, combining sculptural elegance with outstanding crystal quality. The chandelier is constructed around a central gilt bronze stem supporting two richly ornamented circular tiers and eight gracefully curved light arms, each fitted with a candle-style socket. The upper crown is decorated with molded crystal leaf elements, finely carved and precisely fitted, reflecting the refined ornamental vocabulary favored in high-end French lighting during the late 19th century. Multiple strands of large octagonal faceted crystal drops cascade from the upper tier,

leading to a densely decorated lower basket. The lower section is further enhanced by elongated dagger-shaped pendeloques, which amplify the brilliance and create a striking play of light. The clarity, weight, and precision of the crystal cutting are strongly evocative of Baccarat production, renowned worldwide for its optical purity and masterful faceting. The gilt bronze mount is elegant and restrained, carefully designed to support and highlight the crystal without visual heaviness. Its warm patina adds depth and character, underscoring the authenticity and age of the piece. A sophisticated and highly decorative chandelier, ideal for collectors and refined interiors seeking an authentic example of late 19th-century French crystal lighting, attributed to one of the most prestigious crystal manufacturers of the period.
