- Beaker- Hammered, engraved, and gilded silver- By Johann Jacob Frey, master silversmith in 1714- Strassburg, 1714-1725- Height: 8.6 cm; diameters: 4.8 cm (base) & 7.5 cm (rim); weight: 144 g- Used condition, gilding worn- Provenance: private collection- A tulip-shaped cup rests on a foot with wide gadroons bordered by a molding. A frieze of bent, flowered rushes is engraved beneath the molded rim. The body is plain. The number "22" is inscribed.
