Description

A rectangular Biedermeier extending table from France, circa 1820, extending on both sides. Beautiful solid cherry wood, hand-polished with shellac. Tapered and square legs in solid cherry wood with ebony rings. Extendable on both sides, allowing the table to be extended from 195.5 cm to 301 cm. Two side extensions slide under the main tabletop and are supported by long planks of solid oak. The extensions (approximately 79.5 cm long each) consist of a cherry wood frame with chestnut wood in the center. Restored condition.
