The woman is likely the Virgin Mary or Mary Magdalene. These are undoubtedly fragments from a Calvary or a Nativity scene. Depicting two full-length holy figures, clad in belted tunics and mantles with dynamic drapery in the Baroque style. The man--bearded, his face framed by wavy hair--stands on a stepped architectural base. The woman, depicted in a dynamic pose with her right arm raised, stands on a molded quadrangular plinth. Condition Report: As is. Visible damage and losses, particularly to the arms of the male
