Description

This technique, also known as "thread painting," is an ancient decorative art that creates a painting-like effect.

One embroidery depicts Saint Anne and Saint Joachim, along with the Virgin Mary as a child. The other embroidery depicts the Virgin Mary's education.

The figures are created using glued threads, creating texture and depth.

The frames are gilded wood, but are not contemporary with the original embroideries.

These works are examples of devotional art that use a complex artisanal technique to depict biblical and apocryphal scenes.
