A celestial creature linked to water, clouds, and the breath of life, it symbolizes a fluid force, capable of adapting without ever breaking. Unlike the destructive monster, the Japanese dragon is a guardian of balance, combining wisdom, courage, and spiritual authority. For the samurai, it represents the ideal of the accomplished warrior: mastering his violence to act with lucidity and honor.
