The majestic handles are adorned with acanthus leaves, and the sugar bowl has a hinged lid with a pinecone finial. This high-quality Parisian silversmith's work, preserved over time, is accompanied by its matching serving spoons. The meticulously worked crystal, the careful mounting, and the finely retouched chasing all contribute to making this a prestigious and decorative piece.
