Aldo Bitossi (1911-2003), a renowned Italian painter and sculptor, constantly sought to create and innovate his ceramic works, making him the father of modern Italian ceramics. Aldo Londi's blue is inimitable. This carafe is one of his creations from his time working at the Bitossi factory, where he served as artistic director from 1946 to 1976. This inimitable "flayed" style on the ceramic is inspired by his travels in Africa, particularly in Ethiopia. A true aesthete, Aldo Londi forever modernized Italian ceramics, which earned him international success, even in the United States. Iconic of his work, this pitcher is covered with the same glaze that made Aldo Londi and Bitossi famous during their golden age. Beautiful and
