An elegant pair of finely carved and giltwood wall sconces from the Second Empire period (Napoleon III), in the Louis XVI style.

Each sconce features a rich neoclassical design centered on an elegant covered vase with a flame-shaped handle, adorned with finely chiseled laurel garlands. The lower section extends two gracefully curved light arms with foliate scrolls and acanthus motifs, each supporting a candle holder with a scalloped bobèche. The whole rests on a carved base, emphasizing the balance and symmetry characteristic of the Louis XVI style.
