Large 19th-Century Indo-Persian Engraved Brass and Copper Gourd. When utility and decoration combine, the result is objects of folk art from the Indo-Persian peoples, such as this gourd. Large in size, this gourd has a pointed stopper to protect its contents (water or powder), and two handles on the side for attaching it, most likely to the side of an animal such as a horse or camel. The entire gourd is covered with hammered metal motifs, crafted from a blend of brass and food-grade copper, worthy of the 19th-century craftsmanship from which it originates. Perfect for decoration today, this Orientalist folk art is just waiting to find its place in a decor that appreciates the talents of the Orient. Please note the base has a small hole.
