A COSTUME ACCESSORY WITH AUSPICIOUS SYMBOLISM - ONE SIDE EMBROIDERED IN GOLD THREAD WITH A CHECKERBOARD AND BOOK DESIGN, THE GAME OF GO, ONE OF THE FOUR ARTS OF LETTERWORK, AND ON THE OTHER SIDE, A DESIGN SYMBOLIZING THE EARTH WITH LOTUS AND PEONIES. - A NET WITH PULL THREADS CREATING A LACE EFFECT ON A GOLD BASE - CROSS STITCH AND MEANDERS - ENDS IN SILK THREAD
