Hallmarked on the base "OC" for Christofle silversmiths, "Gallia," and the model number 0438. Minor dents on the rim. Scratches from use. As is. A piece from the Art Deco period. Dimensions: Width with handles: 27 cm; Diameter: 18.5 cm; Height: 20 cm. Famous for his work at Christofle, for over a quarter of a century, from 1920 to 1946, he was one of the company's most important designers.
