This trunk consists of a wooden frame entirely covered in embossed leather, richly decorated with scrollwork, stylized foliage, and lions--symbols of power and authority prevalent in Spanish iconography of the period. The finely embossed leatherwork is characteristic of South American colonial productions intended for the civil or ecclesiastical elite. The locks, hinges, side handles, and metal elements are original. The trunk is complete and retains all of its original features.
