Description

This Louis XV style salon table embodies the elegance and decorative virtuosity of the 18th century, revisited with finesse. Its undulating top features marquetry that masterfully combines rosewood and palisander to create a radiating motif of great geometric precision. The star-shaped decoration, composed of perfectly symmetrical chevrons, evokes a sunburst whose dark center acts as a focal point. Each segment alternates the warm, veined tones of the rosewood, accentuating the effect of depth and movement. The scalloped edge of the tabletop, highlighted by a delicate molding, reinforces the precious character of the whole. The apron features a chevron veneer that subtly extends the decoration of the top. The four cabriole legs, terminating in gilt bronze sabots, give the piece a
