Description

This mahogany chaise longue, dating from the early 19th century, elegantly embodies the aesthetic codes of the Restoration period. Its asymmetrical profile, with a backrest raised at one side, evokes refined interiors where the art of conversation was cultivated as much as that of relaxation. The mahogany wood, with its warm patina, lends the piece a discreet nobility. The finely molded, turned legs recall the Empire influences still present in the early decades of the century, while also heralding a new sobriety. The perfectly balanced structure testifies to masterful cabinetmaking, where every joint is designed for durability. The velvet upholstery adds a luminous and contemporary touch without betraying the spirit of the piece. It highlights the soft lines of the seat and back, while the removable cylindrical
