The lower section features a meticulously inlaid door, opening to reveal two adjustable shelves mounted on racks, allowing for flexible

organization. It echoes the same carved handle as the upper section, ensuring aesthetic harmony.

The uprights of the piece form gadrooned columns that extend to the gadrooned olive feet.
