two-tone design. The traditional curb links
alternate between yellow and white gold, each
polished to a smooth finish to create a refined
bi-color appearance. The necklace displays a
classic, well-balanced profile with closely
interlocking links forming a continuous and fluid
line around the neck. The piece is unmarked;
while UK legislation permits unhallmarked gold
items under one gram, the substantial weight of
this necklace indicates that formal hallmarks were
not applied at the time of manufacture, a
circumstance not uncommon in period
jewellery. The necklace secures with a clasp
