A propelling pencil case, made by the renowned English silversmiths S. Mordan & Co. The item is crafted from 9-carat gold (purity 375) with clear hallmarks visible, including the maker's mark "S.MORDAN&CO", the initials "SM & Co", and the standard "375" mark. It was hallmarked in London between May 1905 and May 1906, placing it in the Edwardian era. Sampson Mordan & Co. were famous for patenting the first mechanical pencils.
