Impressive mid-18th century oval frame from the Emilia region, positioned stylistically between late Louis XV and early Louis XVI. Finely carved with foliate motifs and interlaced ribbons, the crest features an elegant love knot, a decorative element that anticipates the emerging neoclassical taste while retaining a rocaille foundation. The surface is silvered and mecca-gilt; the oxidation of the silver and the heavily worn mecca finish create a warm, deeply authentic patina highly valued by collectors. Large in scale, suitable for an oval portrait, mirror, or decorative painting. Good structural condition, with surface wear consistent with age.
