"Raoul Larche, Loïe Fuller Lamp, Art Nouveau Bronze" Raoul LARCHE (1860-1912)

Lamp-sculpture representing Loïe Fuller in bronze with a gilt patina, re-edition (sand casting technique of the period and original gilding). The work is signed at the base and measures 33 cm in height. Note: This lamp is an artistic interpretation of the famous American dancer Mary Louise Fuller, known as Loïe Fuller (1862-1925). Renowned for her choreography in which she swirled her veils, Fuller twirled on a glass surface lit from below by side spotlights. Wrapped in meters and meters of light fabric, she created luminous, moving forms on stage.
