Description

Austrian marriage chest, dating from the late 18th century. Crafted in blond walnut, it features finely applied veneer work and understated geometric marquetry, characteristic of Central European workshops known for their restrained elegance and harmonious proportions. The slightly domed lid lends the piece a soft, balanced profile, while the two original wrought-iron side handles highlight its utilitarian purpose and the artisanal metalwork of the period. The interior includes a small compartment, a traditional feature of bridal trousseau furniture intended for storing valuables. Condition: good overall, consistent with age and use. A light, non-invasive restoration would enhance its natural sheen and restore its full functional and aesthetic appeal.
