Description: This architectural mirror is distinguished by its structure of detached columns framing the glass, surmounted by a triangular pediment decorated with an elegant bronze motif of stylized foliage. The gilt bronze decorative elements include: Central rosettes; Palmette and stylized leaf motifs; Symmetrical friezes with neoclassical decoration; Cylindrical columns with chased bronze rings; Winged figures/antique figures applied to the lower uprights; Central rosette ornament at the level of the lower rail.
