Pair of rare gilt bronze candlesticks - First Empire period. Height: 28 cm. Base diameter: 12 cm. Elegant and highly symbolic, this pair of gilt bronze candlesticks embodies the very spirit of the First Empire and pays a brilliant tribute to Napoleon's military glory. The stem, remarkable for its composition, represents a bundle of crossed rifles, surmounted by unfurled flags, and supports a socket adorned with an inverted helmet with a plumed crest - a rare and daring detail, evoking the splendor of the Imperial Army. The whole rests on a finely crafted circular base, imitating a mound strewn with grass and flowers, adorned with a laurel wreath, a symbol of victory. This early 19th-century work, firmly rooted in the style and conventions of the First Empire, is aimed directly at discerning collectors and
