This work depicts a stylized dancer holding two onyx balls, in an elegant and dynamic composition characteristic of the Art Deco aesthetic of the 1930s. The piece is crafted in patinated metal, embellished with onyx balls, and presented on a black marble pedestal. This is a contemporary posthumous cast by the Le Verrier Foundry, accompanied by its certificate of authenticity. The artist Denis is a name frequently associated with French Art Deco sculpture, particularly in the decorative bronze productions distributed by major Parisian foundries.
