René Bonhomme executed this magnificent portrait after a painting by Rembrandt depicting a seated old man holding his cane. Here, our artist chose to focus solely on the face of the figure. The quality of the enamel's execution, the depth of color, and the attention to detail make it a work of art in its own right. The plaque bears the artist's signature in the lower right corner and his source of inspiration in the lower left. It is sold with a gilded and sculpted frame.
