### Description

Large ink and watercolor on paper depicting a richly detailed medieval scene, where a man and a woman on horseback are riding towards ships. Signed Félix Jobbé-Duval, dated 1950. Good condition. Dimensions without frame: 64cm x 45cm. Félix Pol Jobbé-Duval (1879-1961) was one of the great french illustrators of the twentieth century, active for six decades. Born in Rennes into a family of artists, he went to study at the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris, then, before the First World War, became a cartoonist for the magazines Froufrou, Le Sourire, Fantasio, and Le Rire. He was mobilized in 1914 and worked for the magazines La Baïonnette and Le Rire Rouge, and founded a trench newspaper. After the war, he focused his career, permanently, on children's books, working first for Ric et Rac, then Lisette,
