Expressive walking stick handle carved from antler, depicting a two-faced grotesque head, one face laughing and the other melancholic, in the style of theatrical masks. A fine work in the round, with lively and caricatured modeling: a deliberately elongated nose, an animated mouth, and inlaid glass eyes that lend intensity to the gaze. Beautiful, aged honey patina. Late 19th - early 20th century (circa 1880-1910). Length: approx. 10 cm Height: approx. 4-5 cm Good condition, wear consistent with age.
