Hard-paste porcelain, painted and enhanced with gilding. Marked with a red-iron vignette. Dimensions: Saucer diameter; Height (cm). Paris, circa 1810-1819. Jasmine cup, scroll handle with a dark nankeen "tiger" pattern on the cup, and geometric friezes. The center of the saucer is monogrammed. The Dagoty factory. Founded by Pierre-Louis Dagoty and his brothers in 1798, this is a perfect example of the golden age of hard-paste porcelain in Paris. Their work is recognizable by the use of "thick gold" and sumptuous painted decorations, often combined with areas left unpainted. Their success allowed them to become the Empress's Manufactory in
